## Seadrift Market Guidelines

The Seadrift Market is a community event promoting our local vendors, farmers, artisans, and craftsmen. The market is held last Saturday each month in Seadrift Texas from 8:00 a.m. to 2 p.m.

- Vendors must complete and submit an application by the Thursday prior to the event. Application is available on our website at <a href="www.seadriftchamber.com">www.seadriftchamber.com</a>. Applications must be submitted by email to <a href="seadriftchambertx@gmail.com">seadriftchambertx@gmail.com</a>. Applications are reviewed by the Seadrift Chamber of Commerce and can be denied based on the overall fit for the Seadrift Market. We will only accept applications for NEW items being sold. No garage sale/used items are allowed. We will also allow one of each brand's vendor (i.e. Tupperware, Avon, etc.) Applications are only required the FIRST time you exhibit and if you change the items you plan to sell.
- Vendor space is on a first come basis with setup starting at 7 a.m., the day of the market.
- Each vendor may bring a 10x10 tent, table and chairs. There are no covered sites or electricity provided. Lavatory facilities will be available for vendors and customers.
- Vendors selling food must adhere to all rules provided by the Texas Department of Human Services including, but not limited to, labeling requirements.
- Vendors are responsible for their own trash. If you have items, such as sample cups or disposable food containers, you will be responsible for bringing a trash can for these items to be disposed of properly.
- Ensure that your space is clean, and all items are removed when you take down your spot. All vendors are required to exit the premises by 2:30 p.m.
- Each vendor is responsible for collecting their own sales tax for items sold that are taxable under Texas State Law.
